Appointment

Call the Student Health Services center to speak to a nurse and schedule an appointment. Remember that your GUU ID card is required for all visits.

Cost

Patients are responsible for costs associated with medical services, prescriptions, lab work, immunizations, some procedures and materials for programs.

Patients who are covered under the **Student Health Insurance** can discuss the costs
and coverage with a staff nurse.

Student Health Insurance

Student Health Services only accepts **Student Health Insurance**. The plan is administered by Academic Health Plans for the school year—protecting students at school, at home and while traveling or studying abroad.

Confidentiality

Your treatment record is maintained in a secure setting under FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act). All patient visits are private and confidential. Your visits and treatment information aren't shared with anyone unless we have written consent from you.

After Hours

If medical attention is needed after clinic hours, please refer to the campus website for urgent care, hospital and emergency room locations.

Medical Emergencies

For emergencies on campus or in residence halls, call 911 (the same as if you were off campus). The GUU police are first responders to emergency situations and will provide immediate assistance.
