Wide tooth comb

- 1. An even blended haircut from very short at the hairline to longer lengths as you move up the head. Taper
- 2. Cutting technique, where the clippers move sideways across the comb rather than bottom to top. Clipper over-comb
- 3. A parting that starts about two inches below the apex of the head, beginning and ending at the front hairline. Horseshoe parting
- 4. Guideline that moves as the haircutting progresses, used often when creating layers or graduation. Moving guideline
- 5. Taking a panel of hair opposite the original cutting angle and checking for consistency. Cross-check
- 6. Rolling your shoulder back and standing directly (parallel) in front of the section on which you are working. Correct body positioning
- 7. Electrical device that cuts the hair using two moving blades held in place by a metal plate with teeth. Clippers
- 8. A smaller sized clipper, usually cordless, used to clean necklines and around ears.

 Trimmers
- 9. When attached to clippers, these allow you to cut the hair evenly to the exact length.

 Guard attachments
- 10. Used mainly for removing length and detailing the haircut. Haircutting shears

- 11. These tools are great for removing excess bulk and for blending one area with another. Thinning shears
- 12. Finer-spaced teeth used for detailing, shears over-comb, and clipper over-comb techniques. Classic barbering comb
- 13. Tool used when cutting thicker and longer lengths, where detailing is not required. Wide tooth comb
