

Criteria for the Board Game

Working in groups of four to five, research information on one of the topics below and create a board game. The game must include 15 to 20 lesson-related questions. Use the handouts and notes provided in the lesson as possible resources.

Topics:

- Basics of Budgeting
- Careers Available in Consumer Services
- Consumer Rights and Responsibilities
- Impact of Technology on Consumers
- Making Responsible Shopping Decisions

Each game must provide:

- 15 to 20 lesson-related questions. The questions should be challenging and relevant to the topic assigned
- correct answers written/typed on a separate document
- clear instructions and rules governing play
- a clear strategy and purpose for the rules governing the game. Example: The object of the game is to reach "home" with the most money.
- a colorful playing board
- creative game pieces to play with (cards, dice or unique figures to move on the board)

Your game will be assessed with "Rubric for the Board Game."
