I HAVE - WHO HAS ACTIVITY

Print the I Have - Who Has cards below onto cardstock. Run multiple sets if you need to have more than one group. Cut apart and distribute cards to students. Have one student begin by reading the "Who Has" phrase on their card. The student that has the "I Have" phrase that fits, will respond with their "I Have" phrase. That student will then read the "Who Has" phrase on their card. The process continues until all "I Have" and all "Who Has" phrases have been shared.
