<p>APRON</p> <p>Worn to protect yourself and your clothing while working in a lab</p>	<p>BALANCE</p> <p>Scientific instrument that determines the mass of materials</p>
<p>BEAKER</p> <p>A glass container that has a wide mouth and holds solids and liquids</p>	<p>BURET</p> <p>A long, thin cylinder marked to 0.1 of a milliliter: used to transfer exact amounts of a liquid in an experiment</p>
<p>BURNER</p> <p>A piece of equipment that allows one to adjust the size of a flame by controlling the gas supply</p>	<p>CALIBRATION</p> <p>Checking, adjusting, or standardizing the marks on a measuring instrument</p>

<p>ERLENMEYER FLASK</p> <p>A cone-shaped container with a narrow neck and a broad, flat bottom</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Used to swirl liquid without spilling 	<p>FUNNEL</p> <p>A hollow cone with a tube extending from the smaller end that is designed to catch and direct a downward flow</p>
<p>GLOVES</p> <p>Worn to protect hands from heat or sharp objects</p>	<p>GOGGLES</p> <p>Worn to protect your eyes while working in the lab</p>
<p>GRADUATED CYLINDER</p> <p>A tall, cylindrical container used for measuring the volume of liquids</p>	<p>MENISCUS</p> <p>The curved upper surface of a column of liquid</p>

<p>MICROSCOPE</p> <p>A scientific instrument used to see tiny organisms</p>	<p>PETRI DISH</p> <p>A shallow dish with a loose-fitting cover used to grow bacteria</p>
<p>RING STAND</p> <p>A metal stand consisting of a long, upright rod attached to a heavy rectangular base that is used with rings and clamps for supporting laboratory apparatus</p>	<p>TARE</p> <p>Weight of a container when it is empty</p>
<p>TEST TUBE</p> <p>A cylindrical container that holds a small quantity of a solid or liquid</p>	<p>THERMOMETER</p> <p>An instrument used to measure temperature consisting of a glass bulb attached to a fine tube of glass with a numbered scale and containing a liquid (mercury or colored alcohol)</p>
